- ➔ The Business Administration (BUAD) Minor consists of **24 units**; all must be completed with a grade equivalent of **2.00 or higher**. Non-CBE majors who elect an BUAD Minor are not formally admitted to the College of Business and Economics and will not graduate from CBE.
- ➔ This minor is **NOT** available to students who have a major in Accounting (PACT/ACCT), Business Administration (PBUA/BUAD), E-Business/Business Systems & Processes (PEBU/EBUS), or dual majors that include Accounting, Business Administration, and/or E-Business/Business Systems & Processes.
- ➔ No more than **12 units** will be accepted toward the BUAD Minor from another higher education institution that is regionally and/or AACSB accredited. At least **12 units** must be completed at Towson University in the following disciplines: ACCT, BUSX, EBUS, ECON, FIN, FPLN, LEGL, MKTG or MNGT.
