



**Requirements for Admission to the Business Systems & Processes (EBUS) Major:**

- A minimum cumulative grade point average (GPA) of 2.0 or higher for all coursework.
- A minimum grade point average (GPA) of 2.70 for ALL lower-level prerequisites, with a minimum grade of 2.00 or higher in each of the lower-level prerequisites.

**Admission Procedure for EBUS:**

At the start of each semester and before registration, the CBE Student Academic and Career Services office will notify PEBU students of their admission status by e-mail to their Towson e-mail addresses. Students who have met the requirements in effect for their catalog year will be automatically admitted to the major and will be eligible to take upper-level "majors-only" CBE courses.

**Students who take upper-level "majors-only" CBE courses before being admitted to the e-Business major do so at their own risk.**

**Term Codes**

Term codes are used for registration in PeopleSoft (My TU).

<b>Minimester</b>	<b>1 + Last 2 digits of year (ex: 16 for 2016) + 1 = 1161</b>
<b>Spring</b>	<b>1 + Last 2 digits of year (ex: 16 for 2016) + 2 = 1162</b>
<b>Summer</b>	<b>1 + Last 2 digits of year (ex: 16 for 2016) + 3 = 1163</b>
<b>Fall</b>	<b>1 + Last 2 digits of year (ex: 16 for 2016) + 4 = 1164</b>

**Registration Tip:** Prerequisites are checked online as you register. A pre-major student who is not accepted to the major and enrolls in an upper-level CBE (BUSX, EBTM, ECON, ENTR, FIN, FPLN, LEGL, MKTG, or MNGT) course will be **disenrolled from the course.**
