## **Graduation Requirements**

Students who have successfully completed all requirements for an undergraduate degree are eligible for graduation. To be eligible to graduate from Towson University you must:

- earn at least 120 units
- earn a minimum cumulative Grade Point Average (GPA) of 2.00
- complete all Core Curriculum categories
- complete a minimum of less 32 upper-division units (300 or 400 level courses)
- complete all requirements for a declared major. NOTE: all music majors MUST earn a grade of "C" or higher in all required courses. The "pass" grading option is not available for courses applied to the major unless otherwise noted in the undergraduate catalog.

Final determination of graduation eligibility is granted by the Graduation Office once a student submits a graduation application.

I understand that students are expected to familiarize themselves with the *Undergraduate Catalog* and that they are to satisfy all published degree requirements. Failure to do so does NOT provide a basis for exceptions to academic requirements or policies. It is my understanding that students will receive assistance from general academic and faculty advisers, but students MUST assume responsibility for completed published degree requirements.
